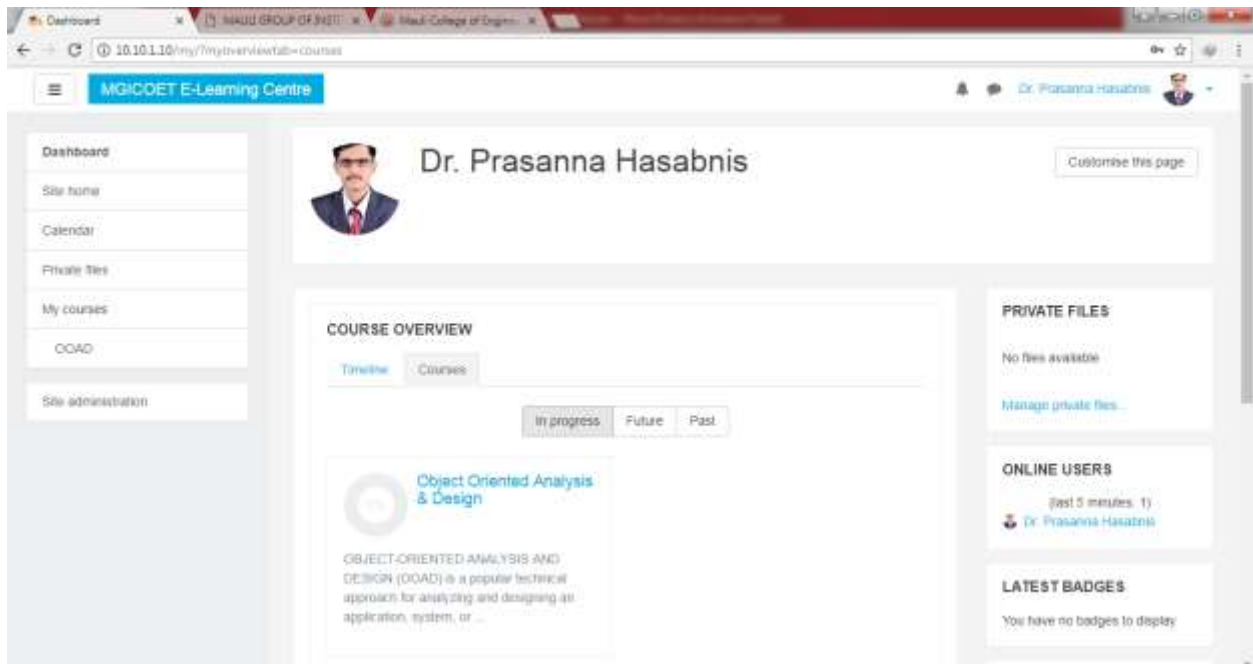

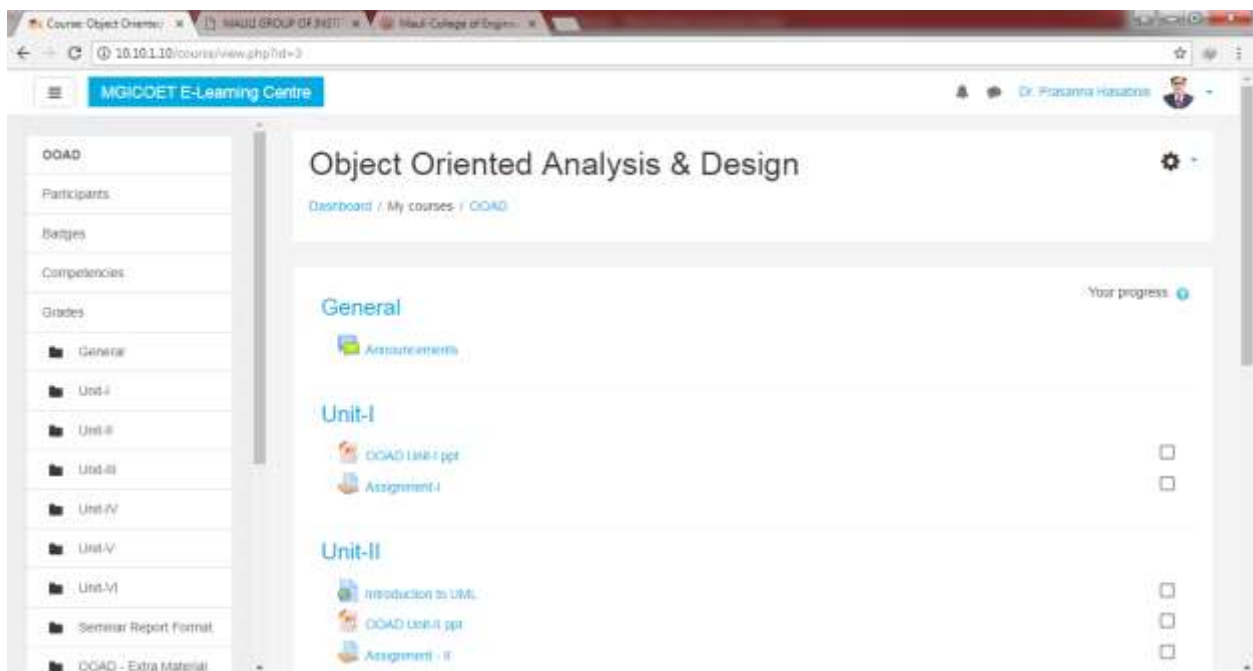
1. Moodle Home Page

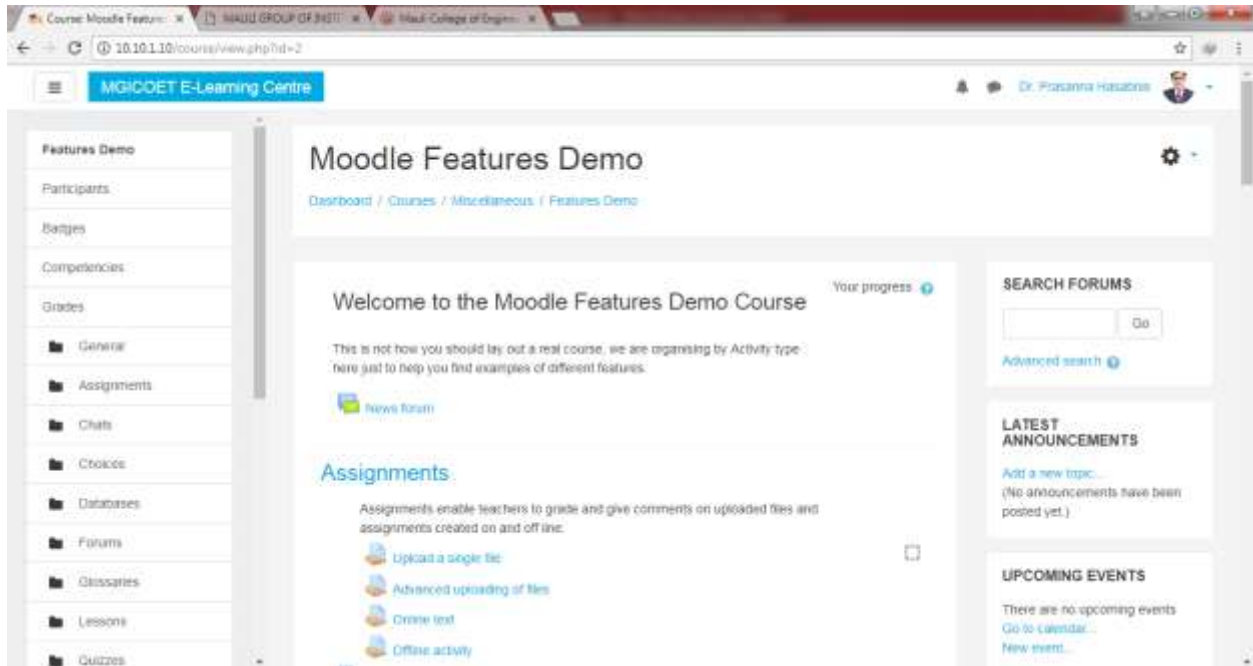
