Report On NSS Camp at Kanarkhed Village

Introduction

The NSS Special Service Camp for the academic year 2024–25 was organized at Kanarkhed village from 19th to 26th January 2025. Day-wise Report

Day 1 – 19th January 2025

The camp began with the arrival of volunteers and camp materials. An introductory meeting was held to explain the objectives and schedule. Students were divided into different teams for discipline, cultural programs, Shramdan.

Day 2 – 20th January 2025

The camp was formally inaugurated by Hon. Principal Dr. C. M. Jadhao, along with the Sarpanch and Gram Panchayat members of Kanarkhed. After the inauguration, the first “Shram Sanskar” activity was started, which involved the construction of toilet pits for village households.

Day 3 – 21st January 2025

A Veterinary Health Camp was organized in the morning to help local farmers with animal care. In the afternoon session Mr. Vinod Didvaniya conducted a session on entrepreneurship, explaining how students can start their own businesses. Prof. Santosh Mhaske gave an inspiring talk about the role of students in society. Later, a cleanliness drive was carried out along the village roads by the volunteers.

Day 4 – 22nd January 2025

A session on "Savidhanacha Amrut Mahotsav" and voter awareness was delivered by Dr. Vinod Gaikwad. In afternoon session Prof. Swapnil Umale gave a motivational speech on the life, leadership, and vision of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.

Day 5 – 23rd January 2025
